- Anti-Bump, Pick and Drill barrel which has achieved TS007 / Sold Secure Diamond Grade and Secured By Design accreditation.


WEATHERPROOF

A must to keep the elements at bay! It must have:


- A waterproof door leaf
- A high performance, weather resistant, glazing system
- Weather performance, proven to BS6375 1
 Classification, for weather tightness, air, wind and water


HEAT INSULATION

Keeping your home insulated and your bills down. You require:




- A high performance insulating core

- A door that exceeds Approved Document L of the Building Regulation requirements





ENCLOSED MINI BLIND

The Practical and Attractive Way to Control Light with Style

They have all the advantages of traditional 'exposed' mini blinds, providing excellent light control, UV control and privacy but none of the hassles. The two panes of toughened safety glass are held in an aluminium frame that never needs painting. These totally enclose the blind and help aid allergen control while protecting the blind and mechanism so that no dusting or cleaning of the shutters is necessary.

A safety feature for children is that there are no exposed cords, as the blind is raised and lowered by one magnetic tab, while the other controls the tilt...all the privacy without the need for opaque glass.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Care and Maintenance of your Composite Door

Your new insulated composite door is strong, durable and secure, and manufactured to an exacting and high quality specification. It's strength comes from the construction of its sub-frame in solid, water-resistant polymer material, reinforced behind with Laminated Veneered Lumber (LVL). The thermoset GRP skins are then bonded to this sub frame, and its core filled with high density, 100% CFC-free polyurethane foam.

The thermoset GRP skins are depression moulded featuring a lifelike grain effect and high definition panels providing an authentic timber like door with all the advantages but limited maintenance. Thermoset GRP cannot expand or contract laterally such that the door cannot increase or decrease in size, an advantage over other commonly used materials.

The factory finish colours of White, Black, Blue, Green, Red, Anthracite Grey and Chartwell Green have pre-pigmented GRP skins which are over-sprayed with a UV stable paint.

The doors' insulation properties are excellent in both sound reduction and heat retention. In the case of sound this is particularly helpful in reducing traffic noise, with its high level of thermal insulation, outperforms both timber and PVC-u doors. This insulation contributes to the general energy efficiency of your home, and savings to your bills.

This insulated composite door is environmentally friendly as it rates low in both Global Warming Potential and Ozone Depletion.

This is a door that's well insulated, made to last, looks good, protects your home from both intruders and the elements and will serve you well for many years to come.

- 44.5mm thick door with 7 pre-pigmented colours and 2 wood stains
- Thermoset GRP skins are impact resistant, will not expand, contract or crack

- Proven to PAS 24 and Secured by Design (SBD), the official UK Police initiative supporting 'designing out crime'
- Excellent thermal performance, with an average door leaf centre pane U-Value of 0.6 W/mtr²/K
- Sound Transmission Class (STC): 29db
- Doorsets conform to UK Building Regulation minimum U Value requirements of 1.6 W/mtr²/K
- Door leaf manufactured to the UK Q-marked quality scheme
- Global Warming Potential (GWP) score of less than 5
- Ozone Depletion Potential (ODP) score zero

Customer care and maintenance of your insulated composite door

To prolong the life of the surface finish and protect your warranty, it is recommended that your door is regularly cleaned by washing with warm soapy water (washing up liquid is suitable) using a soft, lint free cloth. Cleaning may need to be more frequent if your location is coastal, heavily industrialised or near a main road.

Important - do no

- Use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads on the surface of the door
- Use high pressure or steam cleaners
- Use any type of bleach, solvent (eg white spirit, methylated spirit, cellulose thinners or acetone/nail varnish remover)
- Use adhesives of any type or tack for providing temporary protection or fixing of seasonal or other decorations etc.
